AGM

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) is an important meeting for members to attend. At the AGM you will hear a recap of the year's work conducted by our Board of Directors and our committees, review the financial position of the Banff Trail Community Association, and have input into what you want to see next year. In addition to all of this, a new board will be elected. To be eligible to vote at the AGM you must have your membership renewed 30 days prior to the meeting and live within the Banff Trail Community boundaries.





HUMBLE HARVEST BANFF TRAIL

The Banff Trail Community has a new free food resource for those in need. The pantry, started by the Humble Harvest group is located one block from the Community Association (see the map above). Find more information about the Humble Harvest Group on Facebook. Some info from their site states: "Food security is a key issue across the country, and especially here in Calgary. Having been on both sides of food-giving, jumping on board with Humble Harvest - a 'food rescue' initiative that began in Ontario - seemed like a win-win. Items from local stores and partners are provided in the hopes that someone who needs it can use it.

The ultimate goal is to launch pantries all across the city, along with pop up pantries and partnerships with other organizations, to help create a greater sense of food security for all."
